Kevin Steps Down as Chair



After four years of dedicated service, at the Annual General Meeting Kevin stepped down from his role as Chair of the FoWP.

Since the very early days of FoWP, Kevin has been an invaluable member actively participating in and leading numerous volunteer initiatives.

His passion for preserving the park's heritage was evident in his commitment to maintaining Lodge One, the gateway to Wollaton Park, and his involvement in hall tasks and the upkeep of the 508 War Memorial. He was the original "Task Master", organising many regular task days.

Kevin took over as Chair during the autumn of 2020, during the pandemic, and was instrumental in successfully steering FoWP and its activities in the park and walled garden during that challenging period. The importance of this to our volunteers and the wider community should not be underestimated.

During his tenure as Chair, Kevin sought to foster stronger connections with the wider community by actively participating in volunteer projects, engaging corporate groups, and supporting young volunteers through the Duke of Edinburgh scheme. A significant achievement under his leadership was the registration of FoWP with HMRC, enabling us to use Gift Aid to increase donations by up to 25%.

While Kevin is stepping down as Chair, his dedication to FoWP remains unwavering. He will continue to serve on the committee, providing guidance to the new leadership team and taking on various future volunteer tasks.

At the 2024 Goose Fair Dinner and Nottingham Awards, Friends of Wollaton Park were announced as winners of a Nottingham Award in recognition of its contributions to Wollaton Hall & Park.

Volunteering Update



Conservation activities in the park focused on Derby Road field, where invasive plant species were cut back to preserve the acid grassland, the war memorial cleaned, and

at a second session, the grass was raked to allow light to get to the wildflowers.

In the Walled Garden, there was construction work on the damaged outer wall.



Volunteers also contributed to a Hedgehog survey involving 30 wildlife cameras in the park. The results of the survey will be shared in due course.

Formal Garden



During September the garden was closed to address safety concerns with several trees on the Cedar Lawn. A few of the trees were removed due to a fungal disease to prevent it spreading.

The planting in the formal garden this year was restricted due to council funding challenges. The good news is the Wednesday gardening team has worked alongside staff to come up with alternative, more

cost-effective, planting plans based around hardy perennials rather than annual bedding plants. The design of the new beds has been agreed and re-planting will happen over the coming months. The Hardy Plant Society and Walled Garden group also provided valuable feedback on the design.
